- On one memorable Hash night, we were all returning from putting our food orders in, & walking past the Trivia area, **Slops** called out one of the Trivia answers "Turps" was not impressed
- Turps was an icon of Australian entertainment Industry
- A regular on Bandstand, Graham Kennedy Show, Mike Walsh Show & Bert Newton Show
- He hosted "The new price is right"
- Appeared in shows like Homicide & appeared in many Aussie movies
- His girlfriend back in the 60's was none other than Olivia Newton John.
- And, sadly, he ended up doing Trivia at Pagewood Pub!
- He died of Cancer at age 69 in 2012
