- Been to Kogarah many times Know History.
- Something New Old Moorefield Racecourse.
- Located where TAFE, Moorefield High School and James Cook High School are today and all the houses behind them = corner President Avenue and Highway a big block.
- Open in 1888 Cannon remembers the festivities well.
- Closed 1951.
- Horses arrive from Sydney by Train alight at Kogarah Station and then walk down to the Course.
- Some Trainers walked their hordes from Tempe, Banksia and Sans Souci.
- Here were stables on the city-side of President Avenue between Green and French streets.
- Famous jockeys rode there George Moore, Billy Cook, Edgar Britts (as in 'you give me the Edgar Britts' Shits), Darby Munroe and Jim Pike Jockey of Phar Lap.
- Hiraji trained at Moorefield = won the 1947 Melbourne Cup
- Columnist, owned by Frank Packer and trained at Moorefield, won the 1947 Caulfield Cup.
- Kogarah Golf course was originally in the middle of Moorefield Race course.
- The High schools opened in 1957, 6 years after the racecourse closed.
