- There was a lot of Housing Commission homes in the area it has not had a good name as a result.
- A well known Park in the area is Heffron Park, named after a local politician, Robert Heffron. It opened as a Park in 1972.
- Before that it was a Navy Store in WW2 and the Vietnam War, and then a hostel for Migrants
- It had the big domed corrugated iron buildings if anyone remembers ?
- Hillsdale Bowling Club opened in 1963
- Only 40% of the population were born in Australia next is people born in Bangladesh, making up 6%
- Average House price \$1.65 Million


