Kurnell is a <u>suburb</u> in <u>Sydney</u>, in the state of <u>New South Wales</u>, <u>Australia</u>. It is 21.4 kilometres (13.3 mi) south of the <u>Sydney central business district</u>.

Kurnell is the place where <u>Captain James Cook</u> landed on 29 April 1770, Captain Cook along with his crew stayed at Kurnell for a period of eight days.

The name Kurnell is possibly a corruption of a <u>Dharug</u> term "cunthal", " perhaps meaning "place of or where the wild carrot grows".

On 16 December 2015 a <u>supercell</u> tracked along New South Wales coast producing a strong F2 tornado, high rainfall, hailstones and unusually strong winds.

A "Wind gust of 213 km/h recorded in Kurnell at 10:33am," was "the fastest wind speed recorded in NSW history"
