Hannibal's personal appearance is not described or shown in any indisputable form, so it is difficult to simply point to any direct evidence. Coins minted during the period of his leadership could depict Hannibal but could also depict his father or other relatives. And so how were we to find him on Darling Street???

Circle Report – Hannibal

The bucket was situated in a corner of Callan Park, a short stumble down the road from the Red Lion Pub.

The Callan Park Hospital for the Insane (1878–1914) is a heritage-listed former <u>Insane Asylum</u>, which was subsequently, for a time, used as a college campus, located in the grounds of <u>Callan Park</u>, an area on the shores of <u>Iron Cove</u>. In 1915, the facility was renamed as the Callan Park Mental Hospital and, again in 1976, to Callan Park Hospital. Since 1994, the facility has been formally known as Rozelle Hospital. In April 2008, all Rozelle Hospital services and patients were transferred to <u>Concord Hospital</u>.

In former times the Lunacy Act of 1898 applied for a while and those certified as insane were under the control of the Master of Lunacy. Some ended up in the hospital.

A notable inmate was <u>William James Chidley</u> sex reformer and eccentric, who died at Callan Park 21 December 1916. Others included Henry Lawson's mother, Bea Miles and J.F Archibald, the editor and publisher of the Bulletin magazine.

After enjoying ourselves at the bucket we retreated to the pub to marvel at the architecture and the strangely still lion hiding under the steps.
