Troy Bowron, 25, broke his arm and says he had to give up his job as an upholsterer's apprentice. He is claiming \$750,000 in compensation from the Jannali Inn in southern Sydney and its owner, Kelly Wells, for "permitting the use of pork chops as footwear in circumstances that the defendant knew, or should have known, that such use would have produced a hidden trap".

Mr Bowron is also suing the drinker, Ross Lucock, over the accident in November 1997. One witness told the New South Wales District Court yesterday that he saw Mr Lucock tape the chops to his feet. "He was parading around," he said. Mr Lucock also allegedly rode a skateboard in the pub while wearing the meat. Mr Bowron said he was playing in a pool competition that night. 

Start : McRaes Park Corner of McRaes Avenue and Railway Parade, Penshurst. On On : home cater in the park. BYO



This was Jannali in the 1960s. Clearly visible from the western side of the railway line is the Jannali Inn built in 1957. The street on the hill behind the hotel is Charles Place which started out as little more than a track and used as a short cut to the shops. The main shopping centre is located on Box Road to the right and near the car park is the supermarket established by Flemings which was later bought by Woolworths. In the 1950s, Jannali had a variety of small businesses which early residents remember well such as Laybutts Haberdashery. However, with changes to retail shopping, most gradually disappeared or changed hands over time. The arcade still in use today can be seen here where there is a sign for Bates Arcade in the foreground and near to the railway line.
