What else occurred in 1938?

26 January – Australia officially celebrates its <u>sesquicentennial</u>, the 150th anniversary of <u>European</u> <u>settlement</u>.

6 February – Three hundred beachgoers are dragged out to sea when three freak <u>waves</u> strike <u>Bondi</u> <u>Beach</u> in <u>Sydney</u> in an event known as "Black Sunday". A team of eighty <u>surf lifesavers</u> manage to rescue all but five people. <u>SNIFFER'S</u> mother was there paddling around the shoreline. 15 November – Waterside workers at <u>Port Kembla, New South Wales</u> refuse to load a consignment of scrap iron destined for Japan, arguing that it would be used for munitions. <u>Attorney-General Robert Menzies</u> attempts to force the loading of the cargo, earning himself the nickname "Pig Iron Bob".

5 to 12 February – The <u>1938 British Empire Games</u> are held in <u>Sydney</u>. <u>Australia</u> leads the medal tally at the games, winning 25 gold medals, 19 silver and 22 bronze.
