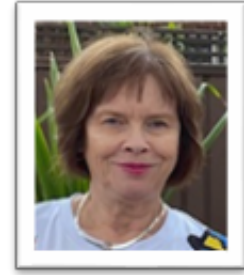

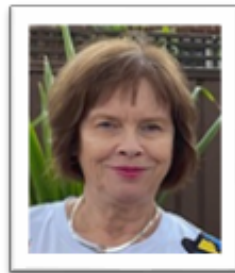

## Hashing

### **THE ORDER OF HASHING and REVELATIONS FOR SETTING A RUN**

Hashing is about Hash running AND Hash drinking. Most of us know about the latter, it comes naturally. It's the running we need to understand, for we all run at different speeds and at different levels. A Hash run must therefore be enjoyable for all and keep everyone together for sufficient time to generate a thirst, which is sated at the Bucket. The ON ON is just as important as the run and should therefore be chosen carefully.

### **REVELATIONS**

The criteria for a good run is to have clearly marked trail with checks and on-backs (false trails) to keep the pack together. A well-marked trail will be followed much easier and keep the pack interested. The run should take approximately 45 minutes, no longer than 60 minutes. The Bucket should be well prepared with enough to quench all thirsts (even the harriettes). The ON ON venue should be suitable for our kind of (mis)behaviour.

### **THE TRAIL**

It should be clearly marked with rapidly biodegradable material such as gyprock or flour. Gyprock

can be knocked off, or "borrowed", from any building site at the plastering stage or from a hardware store. Flour is used for grassy areas and bush trails. (Unfortunately, gyprock is not waterproof so if it rains the trail has to be remarked.)

### **THE ARROWS**

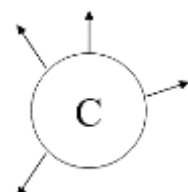
Should be a minimum of 400mm in length and clearly drawn. Each arrow should be laid 20 metres apart. You can never have too many arrows but easily have too few. The more there are the more willingly the pack will follow the trail, and as the Hare, this is what you want!

For winter runs draw arrows under street lights (not in shadows of poles). Recceing at night helps you know where to draw the arrows and bear in mind more cars are parked in the streets at night. Lay the trail in a consistent place, if you start laying arrows on the footpath, continue to do so all the run. The best place to lay them is on the sloping edge of a driveway. When laying flour do so carefully - make sure it can't blow or wash away - a concentrated blob is easier to see than a fuzzy

blur scattered on the ground. Make sure you have enough flour and that you can see one blob to the next. REMEMBER you can never have too much trail. Make sure all hazards such as cliffs, holes, steps are clearly marked to avoid injury and if possible keep off main roads - firstly as some may recognise where they are and short cut and secondly, because of traffic hazards, thirdly, if you have a check on a main road, no one can hear you call ON ON.

### **CHECKS**

Checks are designed to regroup the pack, allowing for the slow runners or walkers to catch up. Minimum of 5 checks per run, more depending on length. A check is marked with a simple circle approximately 1 metre in diameter and placed where it can be clearly seen. The new trail can





commence in any direction radiating from the check and should be start 100 metres away.

### **ON BACKS (OR CHECKBACKS)**

For some Hash clubs, these are marked as a circle with a cross through it. For the B2H3 On Backs are marked with double arrows pointing the way you just came on trail. On Backs enable the pack to stay together and means the true trail has branched off the trail you have just run - go back up to 150 metres.



### **"HARD ON" – Double Arrows**

This is a "Hard On" and means the trail you are on IS definitely ON ON.

### **KEEPING THE PACK TOGETHER**

This is the aim. When the pack gets spread out due to a long run, climbing fences, along cliff tracks, difficult terrain etc, a check or series of checks/on backs is needed to regroup the pack.

### **CALLING - COMMUNICATION IS VITAL TO THE SPIRIT OF THE RUN**

It is both Traditional and Important! Yell "ON ON" to the rest of the pack at every arrow. This way they know they are on trail. Call only when you see an arrow. Other calls are:

"**Checking**" - used when not on trail until the trail is found.

"**Are You On**" - used if in doubt that you are on trail and the response should be "**ON ON**" or "**Checking**".

### **CHECKING**

When we have a check - CHECK - don't leave it to all the usual few to check, participate. If you feel you are not fit enough take someone with you, check both sides of the street, then to check further, one of you remains in hearing distance of the pack and the other checks on. This way, everyone hears and no-one gets left behind or in any kind of danger. Checking can be fun - try it!

### **THE ON HOME**

The "On Home" should be marked clearly and should not be longer than 1 km, preferably 0.5 km. Once "On Home" is written there can be no more checks or trickery, it should lead straight to the bucket.

### **WHO SETS A RUN**

Everyone sets a run. We have 40 odd members (including some absent friends) and 52 Hash runs per year so each member gets about one to two a year. If you set one on your own fine, if you set a joint run you should be getting two a year. This way the TM should have no problems organising a Hare. This is your Hash and you need to participate.

### **THE ON ON**



Should be suitable for our kind of gathering, ie. nothing too plush bearing in mind casual dress, with reasonably priced food and drink. Choose somewhere where we will not disturb other patrons. Ensure the venue will not have a band that will drown out all conversations. Like the runs, the best ON ON's are those which keep us together.
