We had two this week: Loan Arranger – 200 runs and Rabbit – 250 runs. Congratulations!

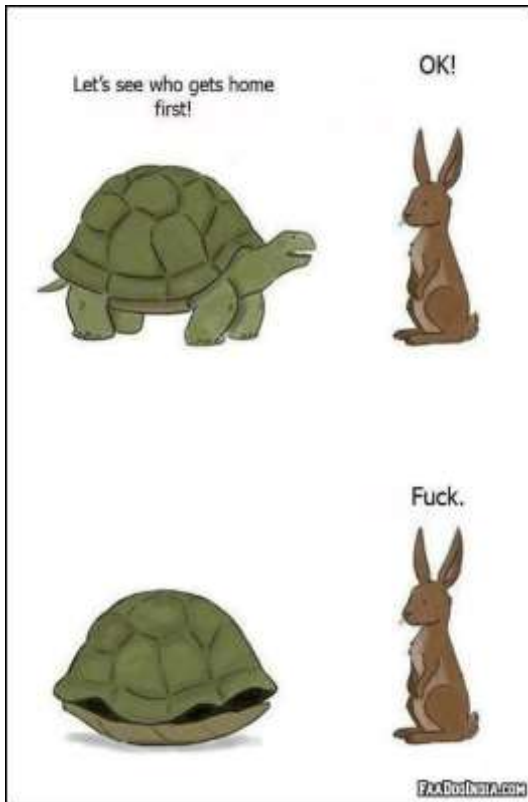
