MELTDOWN.....Always great to see you BRAZILLIAN..... AND YOU TOO!

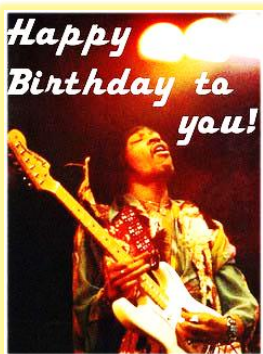
BIRTHDAY: BINGO

"See GOON! perfect fit!"



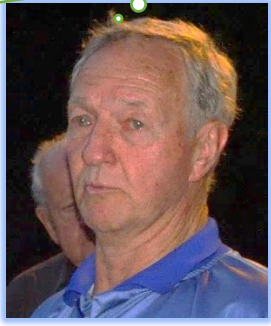

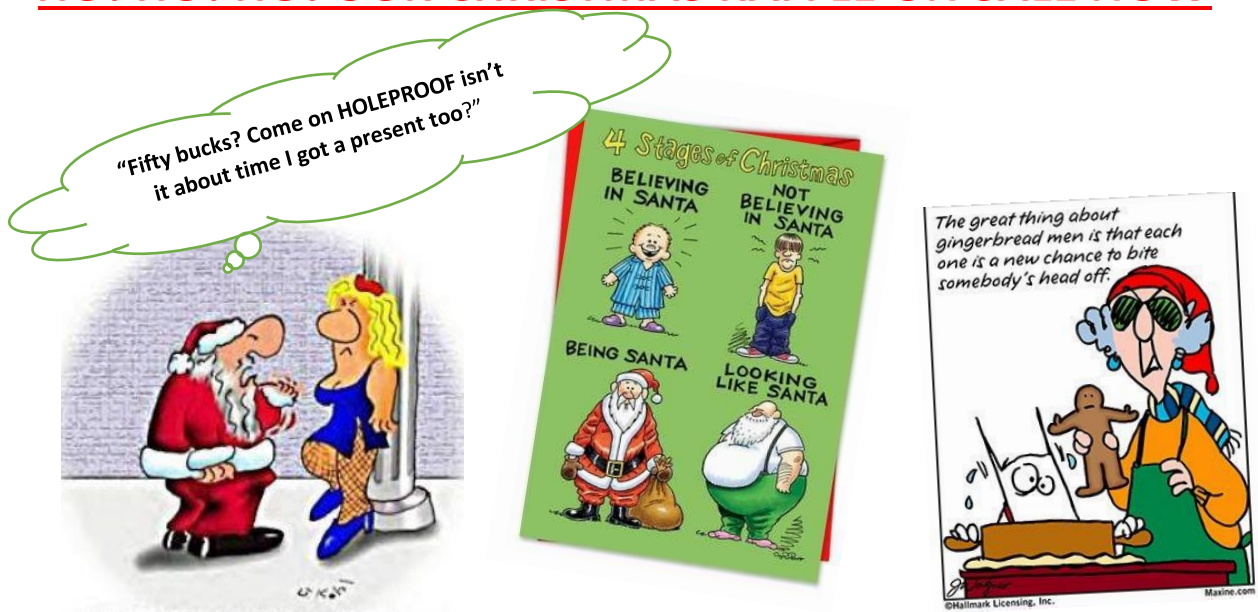
AN EMAIL RECEIVED FROM DUNDEE TUESDAY 28TH NOVEMBER

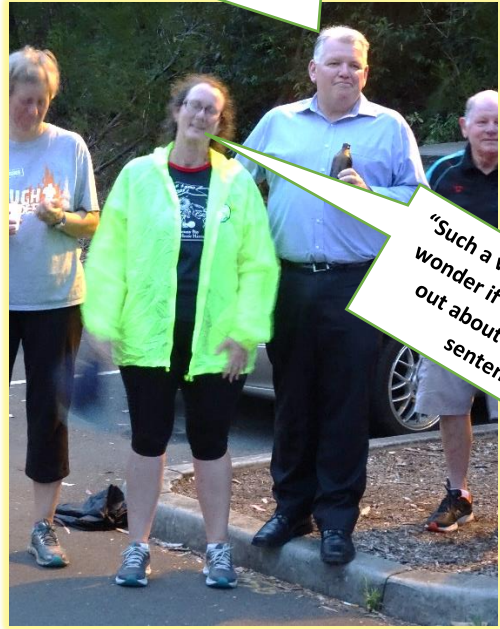

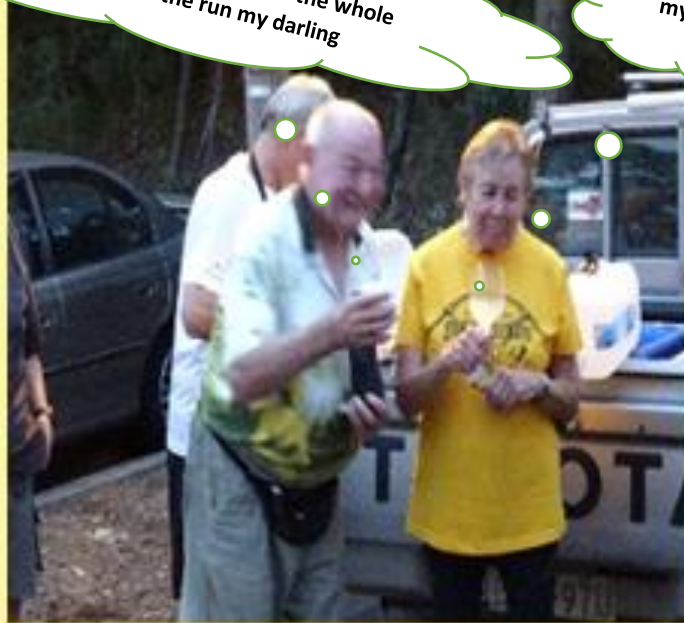



"It's a vicious rumour I was just seeking asylum in Yorkshire but they said NO piss off!"



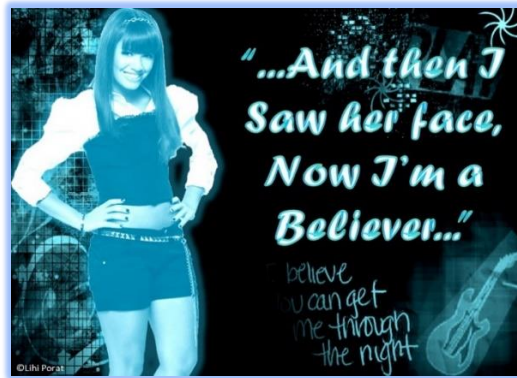
"Ha! Ha! how easy was that? It only cost one Bob to become President!"
