

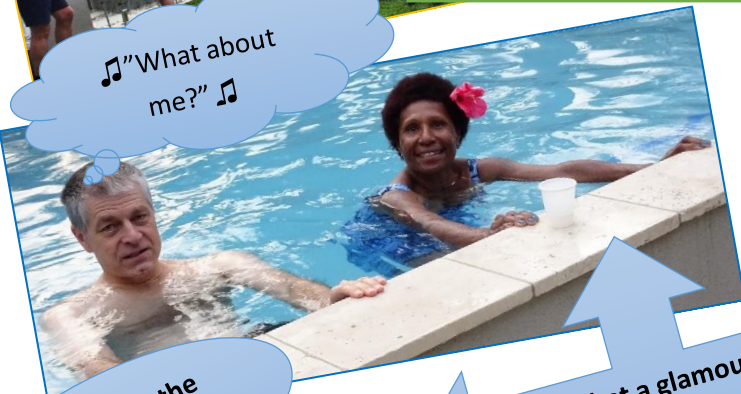

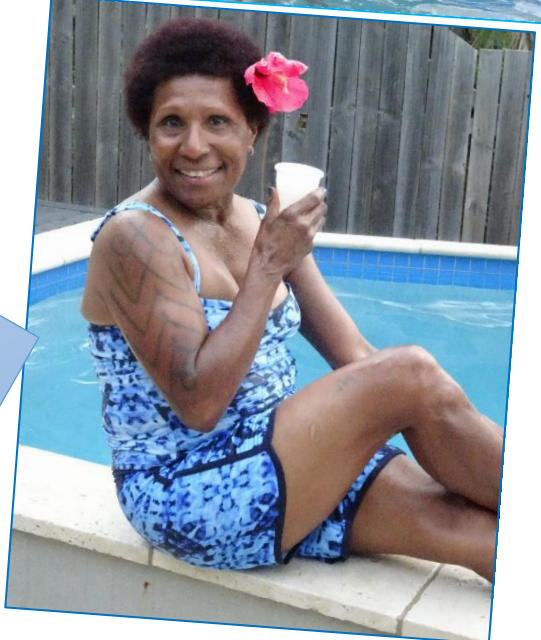

CABRAMATTA BOWLS MERGES WITH BUNDEENA RSL TO CAPTURE THE TOURIST DOLLAR

☐ CABRAMATTA Bowls Club will soon put its stamp on a prime piece of real estate in Sydney's Royal National Park. Members voted by a proportion of two to one at a meeting on April 27 in favour of amalgamating with Bundeena RSL Club. The merger will save Bundeena's beloved community institution, which has been in financial turmoil since it was destroyed by fire in February 2015. Cabramatta Bowls Club chief executive Barry Watkins said the merger was an investment into a growing area. "There are 10,000 tourists going to Bundeena every weekend, and three million a year go into the National Park," Mr Watkins said. "The asset there is the potential growth." Cabramatta will be the enterprise's sole owner after it won out against three other clubs nominated for a merger with Bundeena RSL. The two other clubs almost merged after Bundeena RSL fell on hard times in 2008, but ultimately came one vote short of approval. If the Office of Liquor and Gaming ratifies the merger, the club will be renamed the Bundeena Community and Services Club. It will house an RSL sub-branch and uphold RSL traditions such as the recital of the Ode of Remembrance. "For Cabramatta it's about diversifying our assets and capturing the tourist income," Mr Watkins said. "Cabramatta primarily profits from gaming, entertainment and food; we need to not just rely on gaming."

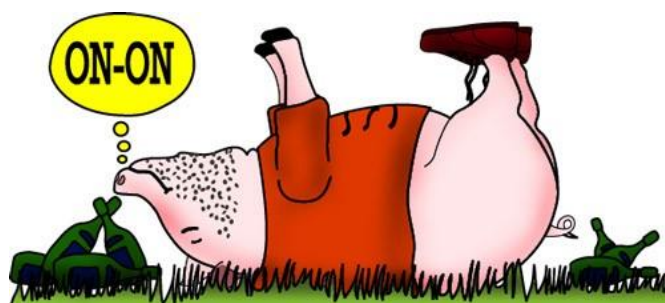
A nice bit of bush with false trails and checks, kept the pack together until the end.
