

HISTORY: White settlement was sparse in the area for many years, owing to the poor soil and swamps. However, in 1838

Coogee was pronounced a township and **DAME NELLIE & KIZZME** set up their home in Athol Street and **DAME NELLIE** set to work to improve the quality of the soil so as

he could start a lawn mowing business!. In 1855 the new village of Long Bay was established and when Long Bay jail was opened it became home to a couple of ex **B2H3** members. In the same year, the Destitute Children's Asylum was set up and I think some of our original **B2H3** members resided there too! In 1859 the Randwick Municipality was proclaimed and the first council elections held. The first thing the Council voted on was to set up Royal Randwick Racecourse or as Ron Casey was always heard saying as he called the races

"It is Won Casey here at the Woyal Wandwick Waces!"

By 1900, almost ninety per cent of the population lived in Randwick, with the remainder mostly in Coogee, and a few people living in the new suburb of Kensington. By 1911, the population had reached more than 18,000, rising to 50,000 in 1921.

CARPET BURN. B2H3 love having CB with us! Your run next week!

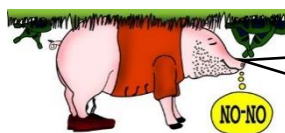
ICEBOX welcome back! Such a long way for you to walk to join us as you live about 200m up the road! Great to see you, where was HOT DICK?

RUN REPORT FROM GOON FOR RUN 1639

DOG, Duke of Gloucester Hotel, RANDWICK

CANOOKIE set her first run with B2H3 in 2009 and has set one to 2 runs each year after that. The runs have never strayed far from the Randwick heartland but have provided wonderful insights into the inner workings of the eastern suburbs parks and bushland.

CANOOKIE'S 10th run at the DOG was no exception. From the trail map provided, it was clear that lots of thought and planning had gone into this one. Various trails had been considered and set, then reset with a tweak. The final version of the run, however, was decided upon with the help of JJ, who used her vast and enormous knowledge of hash runs to recommend a new "in" trail, shorten some shortcuts, add an On-back and check here or there. The result was a great run that went in and out of the park and traversed through Randwick suburbia.

As PIG was re-locating his house and family to Bundeena for a couple of weeks, GOON received the great honour to be TM for the night. This smart move ensured that the front runners had plenty of time to check the checks and on-backs – while GOON slowly staggered, gasped and walked to keep up with them. This nearly also had disastrous consequences, as early in the run, some of the front runners found CANOOKIE "Version 1" arrows (from an earlier version of the run) and were nearly led astray. However, the combination of an excellent map and a stubborn GOON, impelled the pack on to the correct trail.

We traversed around the top of Queens Park, where a long on-back diverted the pack early in to the Park – while the real trail closely followed under the climbing rocks. We then headed down a scenic stairway, before crossing in to Queens Park proper. We found trail between 2 large Fig trees and in the runnable vegetation that skirted the playing oval.

The pack reached another cross-roads at this point and had to decide between run Version 1 and run Version 2. The TM chose V2 – and the pack followed. We headed into the Centennial Park with the cyclists and the ducks. At this stage, CB, her ruptured Achilles and BLONDIE peeled off to find a shorter route. The rest of the park soldiered on – along the park gates. We wiggled through the park – past the potter garden and into the infamous Lachlan swamp to enjoy communing with the fruit bats. It was dark, smelly, noisy and scary.

Once we emerged back into the bright sunlight, the trail took us out of the Park and into the lanes and alleys of the city of east Randwick, which is how we wended our way home.

This was a great run, covering some interesting areas, which good weather provided. The pack largely stayed together and enjoyed the opportunity to run through both Queens Park and Centennial Park – entirely appropriate for a summer run. Thanks, CANOOKIE – we look forward to your next run.










I hope this is helpful! Being such good athletes the walk to the club should not worry you, 15 to 20 minutes max!

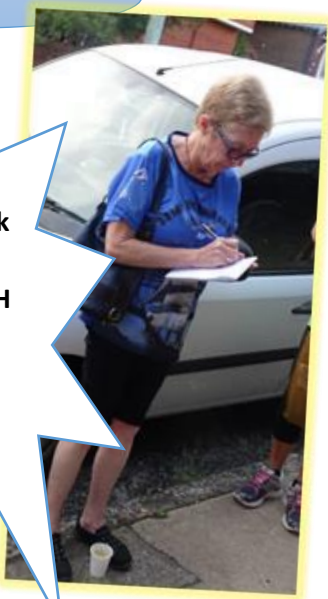
