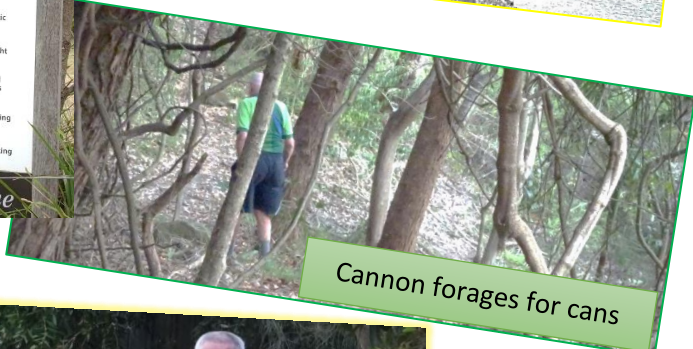
BEFORE THE RUN AND THE END OF THE RUN

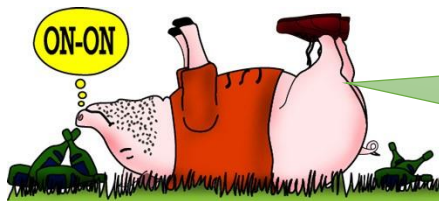

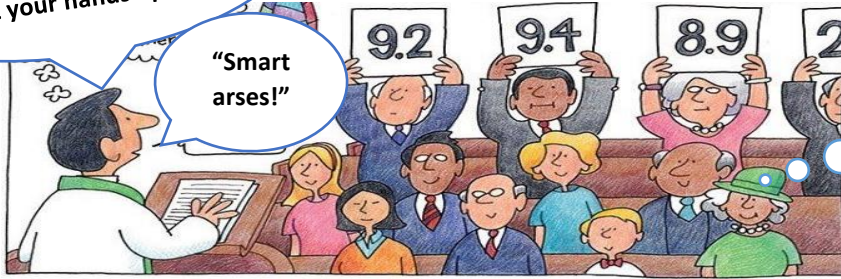











I hope this is helpful! Being such good athletes the walk to the club should

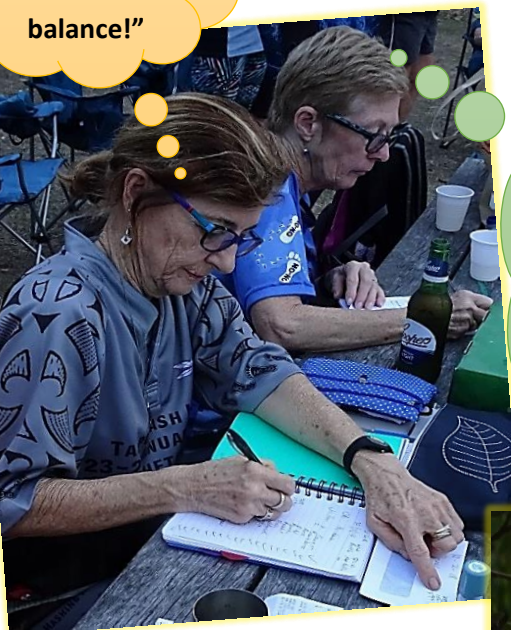

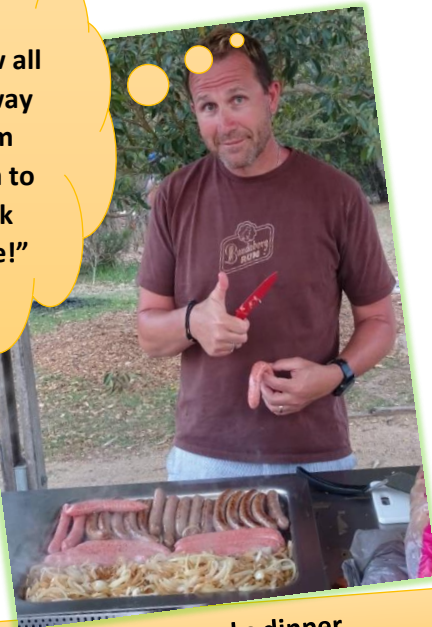
