






Did you know when Kingsford was named Kingsford?

The Kingsford and District News August 19th, 1936 stated:

"The Postal Department had made the official declaration that on and after the 1st of October next, South Kensington's new name would be Kingsford."

Kingsford was selected so that the late aviator Sir Charles Kingsford Smith's name would be perpetuated.



Kingsford was originally intended to be the terminus of the Eastern Suburbs Railway line but, as a cost-cutting measure, the line was

terminated at Bondi Junction in 1979!

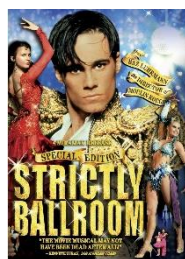
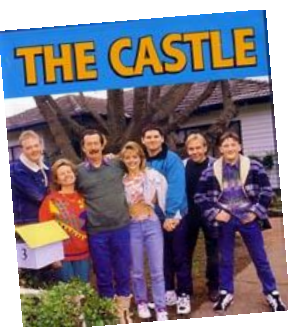

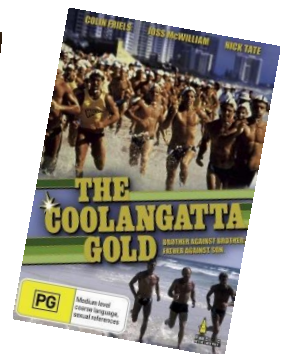
There is a variety of events, something to suit everyone! Marathon, Half Marathon, 10km Run, 5.7 Fun Run and even a Junior Dash!
