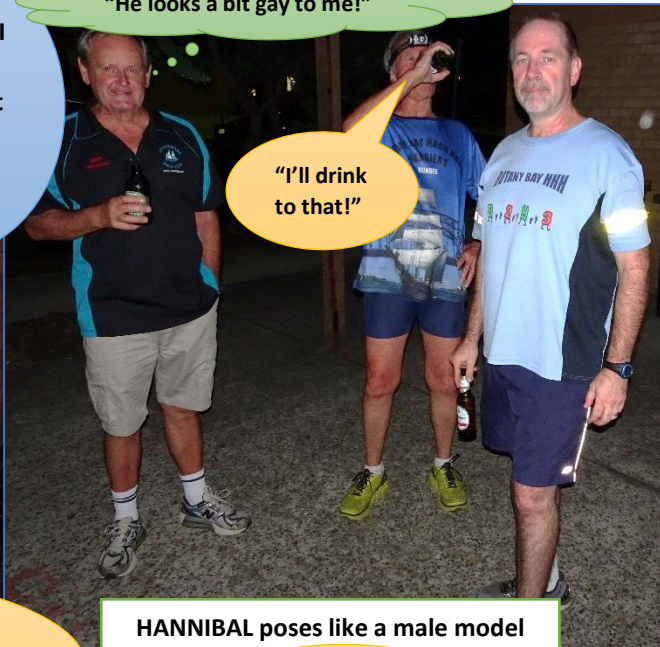

HISTORY: It was soon time to form a circle and pay attention to SNIFFER as she related a rather long and, at times, confusing history of The Intersection and Mick Moylan's Hotel! Following is my history lesson about Ramsgate to add to your knowledge!



I have

great memories of Pemberton's Baths at Ramsgate and I am sure CANNONMOUTH does too! It was here where I learnt to swim as a child. The baths were a hub for swimming, diving and leisure when they opened in 1924. The "aquatic centre", on the corner of The Grand Parade and Ramsgate Road, also attracted elite swimmers from all over



Sydney. The pools had slippery dips, a large sandy sunbaking area, bird cages, fish ponds and outdoor tables where visitors could enjoy refreshments. It also had a small zoo within its walls which was run by "Pop" Pemberton & his son Artie. There was a camel park on the other side of Ramsgate Road, where the Shell service station is now. Sadly for many residents, the baths were replaced in 1972 by a Coles supermarket, which still occupies the site.



Trolley buses and steam trams ran along Rocky Point Road past "The Intersection" in bygone days and also along The Grand Parade where they were often stuck in the sand blown across the road.

RUN REPORTER: Our TM, PIG, appointed himself as the run reporter tonight and his run report follows:

A large pack had gathered at the Intersection Tavern for what is likely to be the last warm run until Spring arrives again. When did it come sexy to call a pub/hotel a tavern?

As I arrived in time, (just) the hare, GRENADE, gave the TM the quick run down of the course and where it went.

A quick dash to the dunny and by the time I had come out the pack were off and running and way ahead.

The pack ended up down the bottom of Torwood Street debating which way to go, either through the park or along the Promenade towards St George Motor Boat Club. This was solved in double quick time as the on arrow was only metres away in the park. To my surprise there was DUNDEE at the back of the pack shortcutting to catch the FRB's! How did he get caught off trail so soon?



Out onto Ramsgate Road where a great opportunity presented itself to slow the pack and have a FT or a check but this was lost and the pack were still racing along Vaudan Street. This was where one of the two checks that the run had was to be found but the pack obviously didn't see it. They continued on Carlton Crescent, that hugged Kogarah Bay, and the check could not be seen due to the very oversize houses and being dark. Into Carrs Park the pack went with the TM still unable to catch the FRB's! How was I going to send them onto FT and the wrong way on checks if I could not catch them? This was not a worry anyway as there were no checks of FT to be found!

TM's note: I found out at the bucket that the Hare just forgot to set any FT or checks!

It was time to SC and try and catch the pack taking anyone behind with me, over the hill, pass the Carrs Park Café and Grill where a group of blokes and girls were banging out a tune on an old Guitar. I finally caught up with ANDREW and SCOTCHMIST. Soon we were joined by TICKLE.

Somehow the pack got divided at this point, PIG and his small band going up Banyala Street which looked the best and shortest way. It was also the way the map showed. We were then joined by JOKER and COLD DUCK. To our surprise we found the second check, not to be fooled and feeling quite stuffed we followed the map and ended up out onto the Princess highway. Bugger this is a long run. In the end a short cut back to the bucket was the only solution, DUCK had already decided this was what he was going to do but the great thing was he arrived back at the bucket after the pack.

A bloody long run (7.5Km) and very few check, a great attempt. A few more checks and on backs would have kept the pack together more. I think this was GRENADE's first attempt at being a hare on her own. I awarded a fine 7.0 On On PIG. **Thank you PIG for this report**

Three visitors tonight, WELCOME

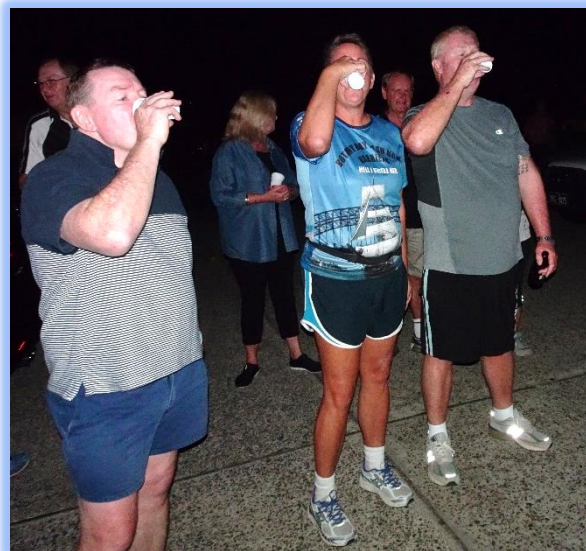

PIG → STEVEN (our visitor) for even though he told us he was born & bred in The Shire he claims now he is an American as his delightful wife is an American

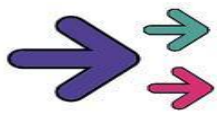
