The Friend in Hand Pub, in the quiet back streets of Glebe, was the venue chosen by our hare

HANNIBAL. Such a great Pub to start the run from! The pack had so much memorabilia to look at before they set out that I think some were reluctant to leave!! This Pub is also unique in that it retains the quaint name it was given over 150 years ago, when pubs with the label Dog and Duck, Plough, Steam Engine, Crooked Billet, Old Blue Pot, Labour in Vain Hotel, Bush Tavern, Black Dog, and Sprig of Shillelagh were the norm around the streets of Sydney. Built as a timber inn by Michael Delohenty, the Friend in Hand was licensed to trade on July 1 1857 after the publican transferred his license of the Albert Inn, from what is today Broadway. He and his wife Honora had been at the helm of the Albert Inn, on what was then known as Parramatta Street, since 1854. Michael hosted the Friend in Hand Inn for 15 years before his death in 1872. His widow



Honora took over as host for many years after her husband's death. Tooth and Company bought the old inn around 1921, and plans for a new hotel, prepared by architect R.M. Joy, were submitted to Council in 1936 and the new building was completed in 1937.

HISTORY: These history notes were supplied by GOON who did a fabulous job of keeping the rabble under control!

WENTWORTH PARK:

Black Wattle Bay was named in 1788 after the Black Wattle tree found at the bay. They subsequently chopped them all down and used them for housing construction.

When first used, the bay was a swampy inlet

fed by a creek that ran from its eastern end. Industrial use by tanners and slaughter houses caused the area to be fouled by noxious fumes and there were many complaints by the residents. **IT SMELT WORSE THAN A HASH FARTING COMPETITION!**

An embankment with a bridge was built across the swamp to provide access from Glebe to Pyrmont, being known as Bridge Rd. The area to the east of the road was filled in becoming Wentworth Park. Greyhound racing began at Wentworth Park in 1932, with Saturday night "Wenty Dogs" soon becoming a part of Sydney life. The current grandstand was completed in 1987. *Thanks GOON for this History lesson.* GOON then read out the following which I thought was worth repeating here:

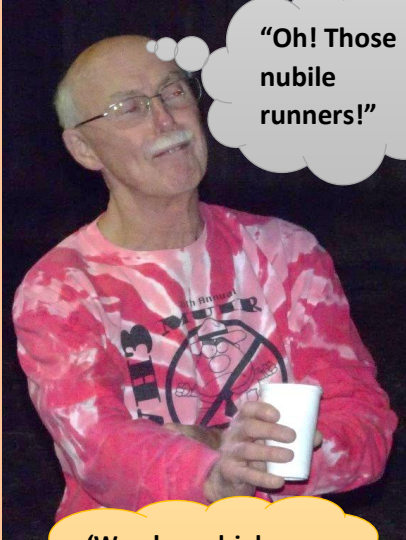

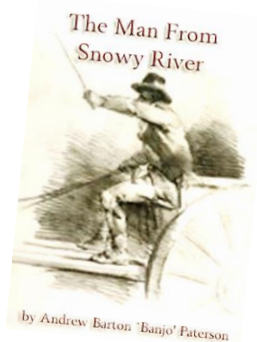

THE ON ON

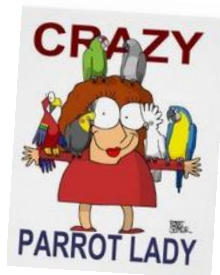

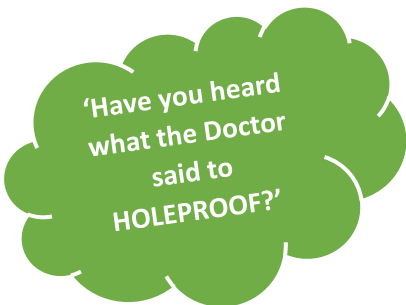

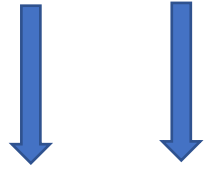
