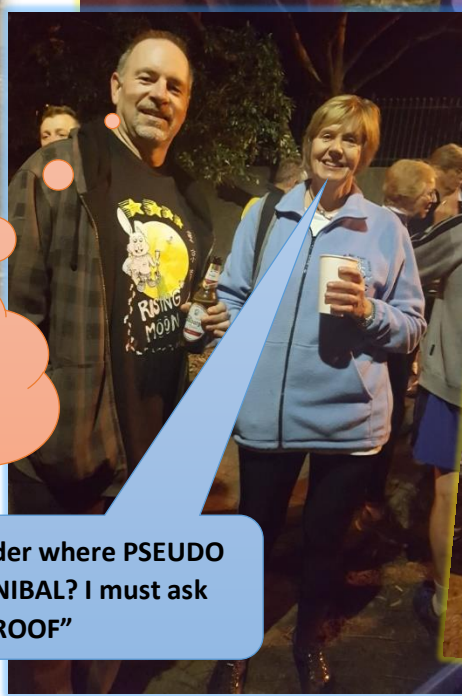

THE CIRCLE

The circle tonight was, as usual, noisy, lots of fun and full of all sorts of truths, lies, make believe and fantasy! Our RA, SNIFFER DOG, had unfortunately left her 'script' at home but with some help, and like a true Harriette, she battled on regardless. Following is some interesting history of Woolloomooloo I have found for you.

The Finger Wharf or Woolloomooloo Wharf is the longest timbered-piled wharf in the world, and was completed in 1915. During its working life for around 70 years, it mainly handled the export of wool, but also acted as a staging point for troop deployment to the World Wars. It was also a disembarking point for new migrants arriving in Australia. The wharf was built by the Sydney Harbour Trust between 1911 and 1915, with the charter to bring order to Sydney Harbour foreshore facilities. The Finger Wharf was an operational working wharf for much of the 20th century. Each of the twin storey sheds was associated with a ship's berth and these berths were numbered 6 and 7 on the east side, and 8 and 9 on the west side.

By the 1970s, new container ports with larger wharfing facilities and cruise liner terminals around the city meant the usage of the wharf declined. By the 1980s, the wharf lay derelict and empty and in 1987 the State Government decided to demolish the wharf. A new marina and resort complex was approved to replace the wharf in Woolloomooloo Bay, but when demolition work was due to begin in January 1991, locals blocked entrance to the site.



Unions imposed a Green Ban which stopped demolition crews from undertaking work. Due to such a strong public outcry, it was decided that the existing wharf would instead be renovated into a boutique hotel, featuring 104 guestrooms, loft-style suites and private residencies. Notable residents now include actor Russell Crowe, billionaire property developer Lang Walker and media personality John Laws.

The wharf in the old days was very odorous and some wags have said that since the above mentioned moved in NOTHING HAS CHANGED! The Old Fish Markets at Bourke and Plunkett Streets Woolloomooloo were opened in 1871. They were extended and altered in 1888 and 1893 to cover the entire block bounded by Bourke, Plunkett, Forbes and Wilson Streets. Then known as the Eastern markets, they were demolished and replaced by the Astor Apartments in the 1960s.

Not too sure where the bells are off to?
 Maybe Bell's Hotel which once belonged to that great Australian boxer Jimmy Carruthers and was the scene of the murder of the publican Shane Miles, 47. Mr Miles passed away two days after being smashed over the head with a bar

stool during a fight at the Bells Hotel, Woolloomooloo, on December 18, 2004. Mr Miles was working behind the bar of his family pub when a group of men came in seeking revenge for a pool table scuffle. He received massive head injuries and died in hospital. The Bells Hotel has been run by the Miles family since 1973.

Times were very tough in the early days of this now affluent suburb, families were large and children often went to bed hungry.



This grocery shop was near the corner of Palmer and Harmer Streets, Woolloomooloo. Reports suggest this photograph was taken in the aftermath of a knifing inside the grocery shop seen here, on a date unknown, c1935.

GREWSOME → MERKIN for mixing up his biceps and hamstrings?

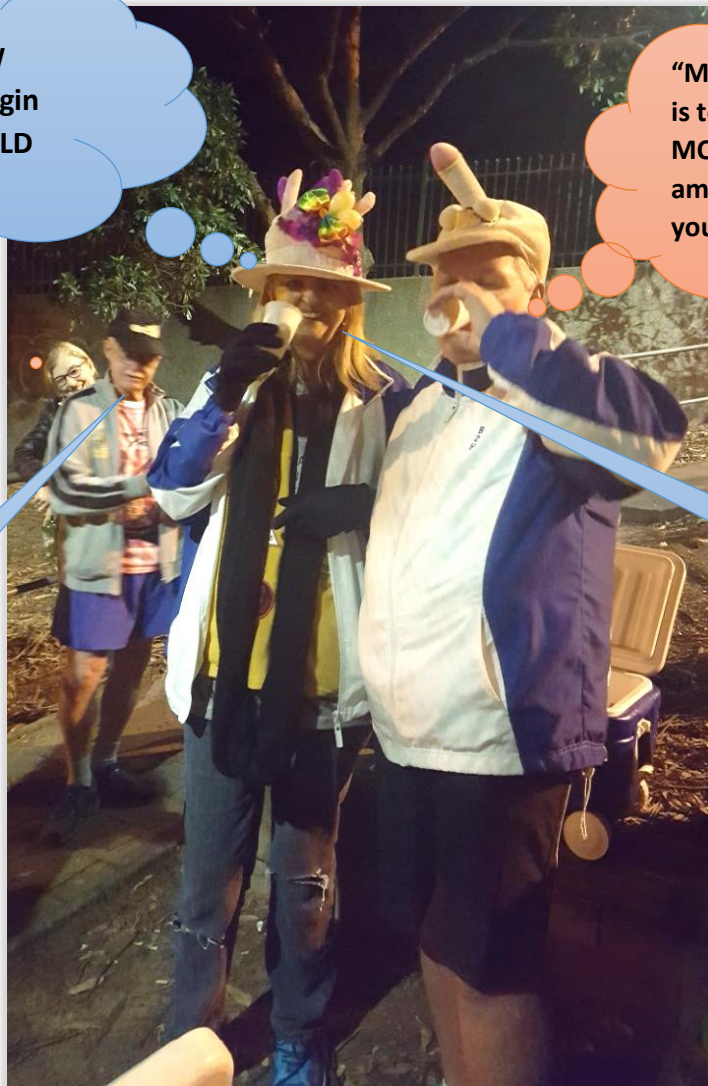



DUNDEE's run was originally clocked at 6.6 kms. This was then increased to 7.1kms due to some running around in circles trying to find the on home.

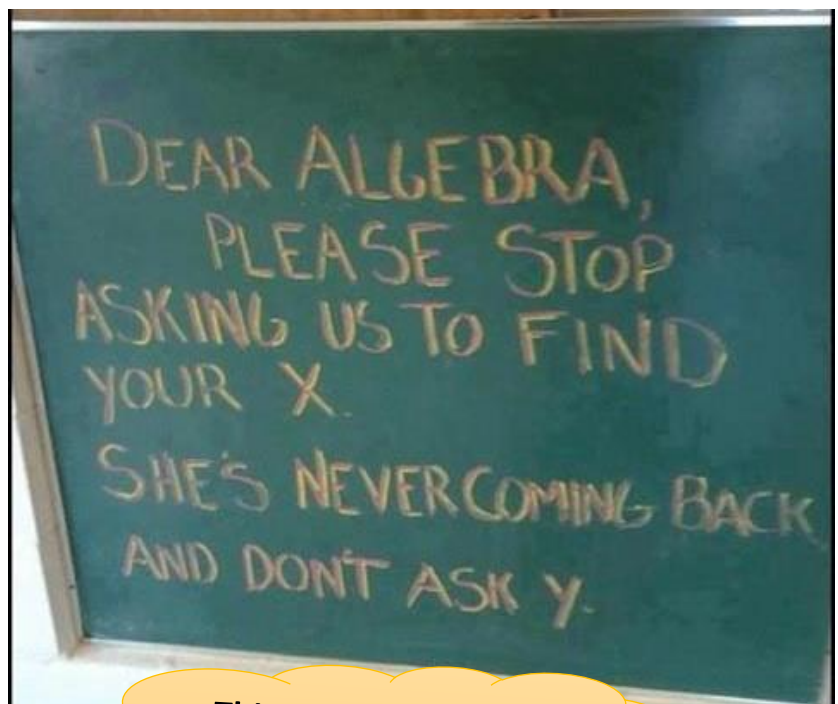
The score awarded was eventually 9.1 which was higher than usual but DUNDEE gained the extra points for the following reasons:
