

Waterview Spa Villa OR Waterview Sunset Villa – Both offer 2 x queen rooms, bathroom (Waterview Spa has spa bath and separate shower OR Waterview Sunset has 2 x bathroom one with shower only and one with shower over bath), FULL kitchen, laundry (Waterview Spa room ONLY), TV, DVD, air-con and Large decks with views.

These rooms can accommodate 2 couples, 2 singles OR just one couple. The cost for the 2 night for this room would be \$370.00, based on 1 or 2 pax per villa. Additional adults are an extra \$25.00 per person per night. Therefore 2 couples would cost \$470.00.

Waterview Standard Cottages – Offers one queen room, bathroom with shower ONLY, FULL Kitchen, TV, DVD, air-con and a large deck with filtered views.

These rooms can accommodate 2 pax ONLY. The cost for the 2 nights for this room would be \$310.00.

Grevillea Cabins – Small cabin with queen bed, ensuite bathroom, FULL kitchen, TV, DVD, and air-con. These rooms can accommodate 2 pax ONLY. The cost for the 2 nights for this room would be \$260.96.5

Thou Walla do not accommodate caravans but if you wish to take your Caravan to Soldiers Point, there is a Caravan Park – Big 4 right next door to the Salamander Bowling Club which is approximately 2 ½ kms from Thou Walla and the Christmas Dinner Venue but very close to possibly a night out on Friday night to the Salamander Bowling Club just a jump over the fence and you are home.

Big 4 have powered sites as at the 22^{nd} February they had quite a few powered sites and advised that the costs are \$44 per caravan per night and have plenty of spaces available (advised that prices may not be correct as at end of July). For those using GPS devices the nearest cross street address is Forest Rd & Lime Kiln Rd Lugarno

For those without any aid, even a street directory, take the Forest Rd exit (left slip lane) at the traffic lights at Peakhurst where Forest Rd from Hurstville/Penshurst/Beverly Hills changes to Henry Lawson Drive. Proceed directly across 7 roundabouts & when you begin descending after a long flat section of road, Lime Kiln Rd is the 2nd street on the left. I will erect a B2H3 sign at the corner for you!

Bus 943 Hurstville to Lugarno leaves from the Hurstville bus interchange on the western side (Forest Rd) of Hurstville Station at **17.38** (5.38pm) & will get you to the bus stop at the corner of Lime Kiln Rd & Forest Rd at 18.05 (6.05pm). This bus also leaves from Penshurst Station at 17.46 (5.46pm).

I hope this helps you find your way as I promise you an excellent scenic run with flat parts, steps, hills, bushland & a half way drink stop! Delicious nibblies at the bucket will help erase the pain of the afore mentioned hills & steps!
