These rooms can accommodate 2 couples, 2 singles OR just one couple. The cost for the 2 night for this room would be \$370.00, based on 1 or 2 pax per villa. Additional adults are an extra \$25.00 per person per night. Therefore 2 couples would cost \$470.00.

Big 4 have powered sites as at the 22<sup>nd</sup> February they had quite a few powered sites and advised that the costs are \$44 per caravan per night and have plenty of spaces available (advised that prices may not be correct as at end of July).
