After removing the roundabout and installing traffic lights accidents fell from 222 a year in 2002 to 13 in 2003.
- ① The Miranda Hotel was the site of Blondie's first run with B2H3 she managed to get her car locked in the Westfield Car Park overnight!
- ① The Royal connection Miranda Hotel was originally called "The Rex"

THE SHREDDER


A young engineer was leaving the office at 5:45 p.m. when he found the CEO standing in front of a shredder with a piece of paper in his hand.
