#Caringbah Drive In – opened in 1956 and closed in 1988 ... was where McDonalds is now on Taren Point Road. "Dirty and I went there when we were courting. I would bring a flagon of Ben Ean Moselle and two chilled glasses. Not sure we saw much of the movies."

#Sutherland Hospital – opened 1958. I am sure many of our group were born there.

McDowall's Department Store – opened in 1961 on the corner of Kingsway and President Avenue opposite the Pub. It was the biggest stand-alone Department Store in Sydney. It became Waltons and is now a bank.

#Caringbah Inn -opened in 1954. Where Pig got kicked out of many years ago. The bouncers did not like the look of him. Where the Sharks players got pissed after training in the 70's and 80's on either Tuesday or Thursday nights. I can not remember. The other drinking venue was Taren Point Pub.
